Please ensure your that your entries conform with the requirements set out in the 'Monthly Competition' document (or meet any announced special requirements.)

For all competition entries please attach a DPI copy of your entry to an email as follows: -

- On the subject line state DPI or PRINT followed by the name of the competition you are entering e.g **DPI Interiors** or **PRINT Interiors**
- In the body of the email name each entry as follows: membership number followed by the name of the image, e.g. **199 A view from a Bridge.jpg**
- Attach the image to the email and use the same name: **199 A view from a Bridge.jpg**
- Send the email to the Otley Camera Club Competition Secretary at the following address - otleycameraclubcomp@gmail.com

Please note If you are submitting both DPI and PRINT entries, it will help if you send two separate emails to avoid any confusion.

Reason for the change

We require a DPI to be submitted so we can

- display them on zoom,
- have a record and
- display placed entries on social media.

We are asking for your help to standardise the formatting of entries. We hope this will make the process faster, easier to make any changes and avoid mistakes such as confusing DPI entries with print entries.

Digital Images

For club entries the size of the image should be no more than 1920px on the longest side. The size of images may differ for external competitions such as the Yorkshire Photographic Union but the competition secretary will let you know the requirements for these competitions in an email.

The names of the images should accurately describe your image but we ask you to try and keep the titles short, i.e. no more than 32 characters. Here again there may be different constraints for external competitions.

A simple acknowledgement for your entries will be sent to you. If this is not received within 24 hours, please check the spam folders for your email and if not received send an email to the competition secretary to chase up.

We appreciate that resizing images in the various sizes and formats can be confusing. If you get stuck, then please do not hesitate to ask any committee member for assistance.

Prints

All prints should be mounted, and we ask that no adhesive tape is visible on the backing/mounting board. Prints are an expensive medium and we try to avoid damage to both yours and other members prints.

Print entries should be placed in the box provided at the clubroom on or before the closing date of the competition.
